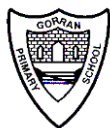

## Stars of the week

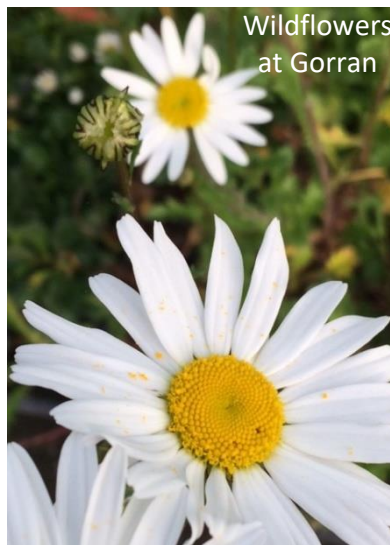
This week's stars are;
