Class Assessments

Over the coming weeks, you may hear your child talking about completing some assessments, including online tests such as CAT4 (P4+P6), PTE and PTM. These are taken by pupils from P3 to P7.

These assessments are just one part of the information staff use to support their understanding of each child's progress and to help inform planning for the next academic year.

Results for pupils in Primary 4–7 will be shared as part of their school report. While Primary 3 assessments are helpful for staff, they do not always provide a full reflection of a child's ability and progress. For this reason, P3 results are not routinely shared, but are available on request.
